



## **Co-operative Bulk Handling Limited - EA Grower Survey 2018 Terms and Conditions**

1. The promoter is the Co-operative Bulk Handling Limited (ABN 29 256 604 947) of Gayfer House, 30 Delhi Street, West Perth, WA 6005.
2. Information on how to enter forms part of these conditions of entry. Participation in this promotion constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry.
3. Entry is open only to growers who receive an email or phone call inviting the grower to complete the Grower Survey.
4. Entrants must be a resident of Australia. Directors, management and employees of the promoter are ineligible to enter.
5. The promotion period commences 12:00pm (WA time), 6 April 2018 and closes 4:59pm (WA time) on 7 May 2018. Entries received after the closing time will be declared invalid.
6. To enter, the grower must submit and complete the Grower Survey online. Each grower may only submit one entry. The promoter will collate each entrant's details and use a computer generated program to randomly select one winning entry.
